



Undergraduate Accreditation Reaffirmation 2024

UC Davis has been fully accredited since 1954 by its regional accreditation agency, the Western Association of Schools and Colleges Senior College and University Commission, commonly referred to as WSCUC. UC Davis received its latest reaffirmation of accreditation in July 2014 and is preparing for its regular, 10-year review of accreditation in 2024. Earning and maintaining accreditation demonstrates that UC Davis's academic programs have met rigorous standards for quality, capacity, and effectiveness. Accreditation also confers a variety of benefits, especially access to federal financial aid resources.

Thematic Pathway for Reaffirmation (TPR)

In 2024, WSCUC will review UC Davis's accreditation under its Thematic Pathways for Reaffirmation (TPR) process, which is afforded to eligible institutions that have demonstrated consistent evidence of a healthy fiscal condition, strong student achievement indicators, and sustained quality performance.

UC Davis's two themes are:

- The 2020 Initiative
- Student Success and Equitable Outcomes

Fall 2023 and Spring 2024

Summer 2024

UC Davis submits its Institutional Report to WSCUC.

Fall 2024

A WSCUC Peer Review Team visits UC Davis from Oct. 30-Nov. 1. During the visit, the team will meet with campus leadership, including the chancellor, provost, deans, and representative of the Academic Senate. The Review Team also will tour the campus and may visit classes or campus programs.

Spring 2025

The WSCUC Commission meets and issues an action decision.
